CHAPTER 61: REGULATION OF SHED ANTLER/HORN COLLECTION

The Wyoming Game and Commission adopted the following regulation governing the collection of shed antlers and horns of big game animals. Under the regulation, **NO PERSON SHALL COLLECT SHED ANTLERS OR HORNS FROM BIG GAME ANIMALS ON PUBLIC LAND WEST OF THE CONTINENTAL DIVIDE, EXCLUDING THE GREAT DIVIDE BASIN, FROM JAN. 1 THROUGH APR. 30 OF EACH CALENDAR YEAR.**

The purpose of the regulation is to minimize harassment or disturbance of big game animals on their winter and spring ranges when animals are most vulnerable to stress.

Collect means to search for, locate, stockpile, or possess shed antlers or horns of big game animals on public land.

Public lands means ALL federal lands and lands owned or administered by the Wyoming Game and Fish Commission.

Failure to abide by the provisions of this regulation shall be punishable as provided by Wyoming statutes for violation of Game and Fish Commission regulations.

This regulation is promulgated by authority of W.S. 23-1-103 and 23-1-302.
