### WHERE TO PURCHASE YOUR AIS DECAL

GREEN RIVER- Based on direction from the Wyoming Legislature, watercraft users in Wyoming are now required to purchase and display an Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) decal. This program has generated a lot of questions from the public. Green River Fisheries Supervisor Robert Keith says if watercraft users do three basic things they will be able to launch their watercraft legally and quickly.

“The first thing people need to do is register their watercraft,” Keith said.

Boat owners can register new watercraft or renew current watercraft registrations at any WGFD regional office. For those registering a new watercraft be sure to bring your certificate of title.

“The second thing to do is purchase an Aquatic Invasive Species Decal.” The decal may be purchased right now on the WGFD web site. Before going online to purchase an AIS decal be sure to know the make, length and type of watercraft and the registration number for motorized watercraft. There is no registration number for non-motorized watercraft.

“One hundred percent of the money generated by decal sales will go to funding AIS education and prevention efforts,” said Keith. Beginning May 17 AIS decals can be purchased at any electronic licensing vendor near your home.

“The third thing to do is drain all water, clean off debris and dry your watercraft after every use.” The department recommends watercraft users complete the self check information sheet prior to heading out to the lake. These forms can be found on-line or picked up at any WGFD regional office. Once completed, the self check form should be displayed in your vehicle window while your watercraft is on the water.

“During the self watercraft check, if you find that you have been on any waters that are infected with invasive mussels, you must have your boat inspected and possibly decontaminated,” said Keith.
